This year we are expecting unprecedented demand for flu vaccinations. We aim to vaccinate 12,500 patients before the end of October so please help us to help you.

If you are attending one of our sites for your vaccination, please could you:-

- Make sure you attend the correct site, it could be Church View Surgery, St Nicholas Surgery in Withernsea or St Patricks Surgery in Patrington
- Arrive at your allocated appointment time
- Attend alone if possible
- Come prepared for the weather, you may need to wait outside for a short time
- Wear a facemask / covering
- As much as we like to see you, please do not stay for a chat
- Let us know if you cannot attend

Please do not attend if you:

- Feel unwell
- Have any symptoms of COVID-19 – a temperature, new or persistent cough, loss of taste or smell
- Have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID 19 in the last 14 days

If we are coming out to you, please could you:-

- Be at home on the given date
- Let any family members know that they can also receive their flu jab at the same time
- Listen for our knock on your door
- Be ready with your sleeve rolled, we'll give the vaccine on the doorstep if possible
- Let us know if you are unwell or have any symptoms of COVID-19 and we will rearrange your appointment
